FOR STARTERS: The Oklahoma City Spark continue their 9-game homestand with the start of a 3-game set against the league-leading Utah Talons on Thursday evening. Utah claimed the first two games of the season series in Salt Lake City June 22-23.

LAST TIME OUT: The Spark dropped the second game of a 2-game set with Portland, 8-4, on July 5. The duo of **Maya Brady** and **Delanie Wisz** both hit their sixth home runs of the season, while **Maddie Penta** had her best outing of the season, going 4.1 innings in relief with just one run and a season-high five strikeouts.

HEATING UP: Oklahoma City has scored 25 runs in its last three games after being held to just 14 runs over the previous five outings. The Spark downed Carolina by a 9-3 margin last Wednesday before a 12-run outburst last night in a five-inning victory over Portland at Tom Heath Field. Oklahoma City ranks second in the AUSL with 84 runs scored through 16 games.

SHE'S BACK: **Maya Brady** returned to the lineup after on July 4 after missing the previous four games due to an injury. She logged two hits on Independence Day and blasted a solo home run on Sunday. Brady leads the AUSL with 16 runs scored, is second in batting percentage (.475) and is tied for third with six home runs.

ALL OR NOTHING: The Spark lead the AUSL with 25 home runs this season with home runs in 11 of 17 games this season, including multiple long balls in nine of those contests.

POWERING UP: Two Spark players, **Sydney Sherrill** and **Delanie Wisz**, both have current 5-game hit streaks. Sherrill has eight hits in her last five games after going 2-for-19 in her previous six contests, while Wisz had a 2-run home run on Sunday. **Jessi Warren**, who returned to the active roster after missing the last four games due to an injury on Sunday, extended her hitting streak to four games with a double down the left field line in the fourth inning.

PICKING UP WHERE SHE LEFT OFF: Since joining the Spark on June 23, **Sydney McKinney** has hits in six of her first seven games this season. McKinney is batting .423 with seven runs scored. She led the AUSL regular season in batting in 2025 with a .486 mark.

WISZ KID: **Delanie Wisz** is tied for third in the AUSL with six home runs, with the last two long balls being 2-run shots after her first four were solo home runs.

WHATEVER IT TAKES: **Bubba Nickles-Camarena** has reached base in 14 of the 17 games this season, including a streak of nine games from June 10-22.

NEW KID ON THE BLOCK: **Sarah Gordon** was picked up from the Athlete Reserve Pool this past week and saw her first action in a Spark uniform on July 4, scoring a run as a pinch runner against Portland. She played eight games with the Utah Talons earlier in the season, going 6-for-13 (.462) with two runs scored and three runs driven in.

STREAK SNAPPED: **Maya Brady's** 16-game hit streak is the longest in AUSL regular season history, but it was snapped when she went 0-for-1 at Utah on June 23 and was subsequently placed on the injured list. Brady was leading the AUSL in home runs (5), RBI (11), hits (16), runs scored (13), total bases (36) and on-base percentage (.590) and was also tied for league lead in batting (.500) before the injury. Brady was reinstated to the active roster on July 3.

THREE'S COMPANY: **Maya Brady** and **Sydney Romero** ripped triples against Chicago on Saturday afternoon, just the third time in AUSL regular season history a team has had two triples in a single game. The Bandits accomplished the feat last season, while the Talons hit two against the Bandits on June 10.

MIGRATORY BIRDS: Utah will head on the road for its last seven games of the regular season, starting with a three-game series at Oklahoma City ... In the Talons' home finale, infielder **Bri Ellis** hit a walk-off home run, her team-leading fourth long ball of the year, to cap a 5-4 comeback win over the Blaze ... Utah won its first game this season when trailing after the fourth inning or later.

IN THE CIRCLE: Today's expected starting pitcher **Georgina Corrick** will be making her third start of the season, authoring a 0.88 earned run average and a 2-0 record ... Corrick made her season debut against the Spark on June 23, allowing one earned run on two hits in 2.0 innings of relief ... The 2025 AUSL Pitcher of the Year has collected the league's longest start, an 8.0-inning complete game against the Blaze on June 25, and longest relief outing, a 7.0-inning stint on July 3 against the Blaze, without allowing an earned run.

SPARKS FLY: The Talons swept the two-game series over the Spark on June 22-23, winning by a combined margin of 11-4 ... Pitcher **Montana Fouts** allowed one run on four hits in a complete game effort in the first game, a 5-1 win, and outfielder **Jadelyn Allchin** hit the AUSL's first-ever inside-the-park grand slam to carry Utah to a 6-3 victory in the series finale ... Allchin's 4-for-6 effort at the plate with six runs batted in led the Utah offense in the opening series.

FLYING ACES: The Talons lead the AUSL with a collective 2.43 earned run average, a .235 opposing batting average and 10 complete games while ranking second with 94 strikeouts ... **Montana Fouts** became the second-ever AUSL pitcher to strike out at least 40 hitters and leads the AUSL in strikeouts (42), innings pitched (46.0), opposing batting average (.184), wins (7) and complete games (5) while also ranking second in opposing batting average at 1.77 and third in earned run average with a 1.83 mark ... Pitcher **Georgina Corrick** ranks second in the AUSL with a 0.88 earned run average, has the league's fifth-lowest opposing batting average of .209 in 24.0 innings and is one of two qualified pitcher to not allow a home run in 2026.

SETTLING IN: The Talons are outscoring opponents 61-30 after the first inning, the best mark in the AUSL ... Utah has only allowed nine multi-run innings after the first inning while collecting 15 multi-run innings at the plate.

DOUBLE DIG-HITS: The Talons recorded double-digit hits for the third time in four games with their 10-hit effort against the Blaze on July 4 ... Utah had collected double-digit hits just twice in their first 14 games before this stretch.

EARLY BIRDS: The Talons saw their lead-off hitter reach base in 7-of-14 trips to the plate against the Blaze ... Utah's lead-off hitters have gotten aboard at a 52-of-120 (.433) clip, the second-best mark in the league, including a 38-for-73 (.521) rate in their last 11 games.

WE ARE GOING TO STEAL... THE BASE!: The Talons are among the league's most efficient teams on the basepaths, stealing 10 bases, the second-most in the AUSL, in 12 attempts ... Outfielder **Jadelyn Allchin** is tied for the league-lead with four swiped bags and outfielder **Aliyah Andrews** has stolen three bases, tied for third in the AUSL.

BACK LIKE THEY NEVER LEFT: Outfielder **Jayda Coleman**, infielder **Bri Ellis** and catcher **Sharlize Palacios** have provided a boost to the Talons offense since returning from the Injured List during the Talons' series with the Volts from June 30-July 1 ... The trio has collectively hit 14-for-36 (.389) with three home runs, four doubles and nine runs batted in while hitting safely in 10-of-11 outings during their final homestand.

ALL-AROUND ALLCHIN: Outfielder **Jadelyn Allchin** has batted 19-for-40 (.475) with eight extra-base hits, 13 runs batted in and 12 runs scored since being placed into the second spot of the lineup on June 18 ... The UCLA standout has reached base in 4-of-6 opportunities as a leadoff hitter and leads the Talons with a .548 success rate in advancement opportunities ... Allchin leads the league with four stolen bases and two triples and ranks second with 15 runs scored and five doubles, third with a .390 batting average and fourth with 15 runs batted in.

RED, WHITE AND BLUE: Six Talons were among the 36 players named to the U.S. Women's National Team Athlete Pool, which is tied for the second-most among AUSL clubs. Outfielder **Jayda Coleman**, pitcher **Megan Faraimo**, infielder **Hannah Flippen**, pitcher **Montana Fouts**, utility player **Sahvanna Jaquish** and catcher **Sharlize Palacios** are eligible to compete in the 2026 International Cup from July 30-August 3 and the 2026 WSBC Women's Softball World Cup Group Stage from September 12-16.
