WE'RE TALKING ABOUT PLAYOFFS?: Utah became the first AUSL team to clinch a playoff spot after their 5-4 victory over the Oklahoma City Spark ... Outfielder **Jadelyn Allchin** and catcher **Sharlize Palacios** hit long balls in the final frame to power the Talons' first seventh-inning comeback of the year ... Pitcher **Megan Faraimo** tossed her third complete game in the win, striking out a career-high 10 hitters and allowing four earned runs on nine hits while throwing 140 pitches, the highest single-game total in the AUSL this year.

IN THE CIRCLE: Today's expected starting pitcher **Montana Fouts** will look to continue her historic dominance in the circle, having already set league records for single-game strikeouts (12) and wins in a season (7) ... In her previous appearance against the Spark, Fouts pitched one of her five complete games, allowing one earned run on four hits while striking out five in Utah's 5-1 win over the Spark on June 22 ... Fouts's last appearance came out of the bullpen, spinning 2.0 perfect innings with one strikeout and earning the win in Utah's July 4 home finale against Carolina.

DUCKS (LEFT) ON THE POND: The Talons' pitching staff has performed its best in high-pressure situations, pitching to a .194 opposing batting average with runners in scoring position and a 1-for-16 (.063) clip with the bases loaded ... Utah has stranded 122-of-178 runners (68.5%) this season, the best mark in the AUSL ... However, the Talons have struggled to drive in their own baserunners, stranding 131-of 214 (61.2%) baserunners.

FLYING ACES: The Talons lead the AUSL with a collective 2.54 earned run average and 12 complete games while ranking second with 108 strikeouts and a .243 opposing batting average ... **Montana Fouts** became the second-ever AUSL pitcher to strike out at least 40 hitters and leads the AUSL in opposing batting average (.177), wins (7) and complete games (5) while also ranking second with 46.0 innings pitched and 42 strikeouts and fourth in earned run average with a 1.83 mark ... Pitcher **Georgina Corrick** leads the AUSL with a 1.37 earned run average and has struck out a league-best 12 batters looking ... Pitcher **Megan Faraimo** ranks fourth in the AUSL with 32 strikeouts and 38.2 innings pitched.

THREE TRUE OUTCOMES: While Utah pitchers often pitch to their third-ranked defense (.972), the Talons have the second-most strikeouts (108) and the second-fewest walks allowed (37) and home runs allowed (12) ... Utah's staff holds a league-best 2.9 strikeout-to-walk ratio, led by a staggering 5.3 strikeout-to-walk ratio by **Montana Fouts**.

ALL-AROUND ALLCHIN: Outfielder **Jadelyn Allchin** has batted 21-for-47 (.447) with four home runs, five doubles, 15 runs batted in and 14 runs scored since being placed into the second spot of the lineup on June 18 ... The UCLA standout has hit long balls in consecutive games and has hit safely in six-straight and 13 of her last 14 games.

FLIPPEN THE SCRIPT: Infielder **Hannah Flippen** collected her first home run of the season on Thursday with a solo shot in the third inning ... After batting 182 with just one extra-base hit and no runs batted in during her first eight games, the Utah product has hit safely in each of her last six games with a 1.059 on-base-plus-slugging percentage.

DON'T NEED MUCH: Utah has found ways to win throughout the 2026 campaign, fashioning a 13-1 record when scoring three or more runs and going 6-3 in their league-most nine one-run games ... Utah has compiled a perfect 10-0 record when leading after five innings, outscoring opponents 22-9 in the sixth inning or later.

GAME-CALLER CALLS GAME: Catcher **Sharlize Palacios** went yard for the first time in 2026 with her go-ahead, two-run homer in the seventh inning, putting a bow on her first three-hit game of the season ... Palacios extended her hitting streak to seven games, tied with outfielder **Jadelyn Allchin** for the most by any Talons hitter, with a fourth-inning double ... The UCLA product is batting 7-for-17 (.412) with six runs batted in during her last five games.

FOR STARTERS: The Oklahoma City Spark conclude their 9-game homestand with their 12th and final home contest of the season on Sunday evening against the AUSL-leading Utah Talons. It is also the rubber match of a 3-game series.

LAST TIME OUT: The Talons scored three runs in the top of the seventh to defeat the Spark, 5-4, on Saturday. Utah and Oklahoma City combined for 19 strikeouts in Saturday's contest, establishing a new Athletes Unlimited Softball League single-game record. Carolina and Portland held the previous standard with 18 strikeouts on July 7, 2026.

SHE'S BACK: Maya Brady returned to the lineup after on July 4 after missing the previous four games due to an injury. She logged two hits on Independence Day, blasted solo home runs in back-to-back games and added a single on Saturday for a 4-game hit streak. Brady leads the AUSL with 18 runs scored, is tied for first in home runs with seven and is fourth in batting percentage (.438).

ALL OR NOTHING: The Spark lead the AUSL with 28 home runs this season with home runs in 13 of 19 games this season, including multiple long balls in 10 of those contests.

POWERING UP: Two Spark players, **Sydney Sherrill** and **Delanie Wisz**, both have current 7-game hit streaks. Sherrill has 11 hits in her last seven games after going 2-for-19 in her previous six contests, while Wisz had a 2-run home run last Sunday and scored the winning run on Thursday.

PICKING UP WHERE SHE LEFT OFF: Since joining the Spark on June 23, **Sydney McKinney** has hits in eight of her first nine games this season. McKinney is batting .469 with nine runs scored. She led the AUSL regular season in batting in 2025 with a .486 mark.

ROUND-TRIPPER ROMERO: **Sydney Romero** hit her seventh home run of the season on Saturday, which ties her for the AUSL lead.

WISZ KID: **Delanie Wisz** is tied for fourth in the AUSL with six home runs, with the last two long balls being 2-run shots after her first four were solo home runs.

NEW KID ON THE BLOCK: **Sarah Gordon** was picked up from the Athlete Reserve Pool this past week and saw her first action in a Spark uniform on July 4, scoring a run as a pinch runner against Portland. She played eight games with the Utah Talons earlier in the season, going 6-for-13 (.462) with two runs scored and three runs driven in.

STREAK SNAPPED: **Maya Brady's** 16-game hit streak is the longest in AUSL regular season history, but it was snapped when she went 0-for-1 at Utah on June 23 and was subsequently placed on the injured list. Brady was leading the AUSL in home runs (5), RBI (11), hits (16), runs scored (13), total bases (36) and on-base percentage (.590) and was also tied for league lead in batting (.500) before the injury. Brady was reinstated to the active roster on July 3.

POWER SURGE: The Spark hit four home runs on Saturday, June 13, the second time this season they have hit four in a single game. **Delanie Wisz** hit two solo shots, the seventh time in AUSL regular season history where a player has hit two home runs in a game. **Bubba Nickles-Camarena** belted a 3-run home run, while **Sydney Sherrill** launched a 2-run home run.

POWER SURGE, THE PREQUEL: The Spark crushed four home runs in the season-opening win vs. Texas on June 9. It was the fourth time in AUSL history a team has hit four home runs in a single game. **Maya Brady** and **Sydney Romero** went back-to-back in the second inning, while **Delanie Wisz** and **Jessi Warren** hit solo shots in the fifth and sixth innings, respectively. The Bandits hit four home runs in a game twice in 2025, while the Talons accomplished the feat once.
