NEW TO THE PARTY: The Portland Cascade became the third team to make the AUSL postseason, joining the Utah Talons and Chicago Bandits after coming in a game ahead of fellow expansion team the Oklahoma City Spark at 14-11 on the season.

ANYTHING IT TAKES: Pitcher **Carley Hoover** has been the key to the Cascade's pitching down the second half of the season. Hoover has started in the circle three times and made six appearances in relief after joining the team at the completion of her season in Japan.

WHAT IS THE ANSWER?: During their debut season in the AUSL the Portland Cascade were able to pick up multiple victories against four of the five other teams in the league. The Chicago Bandits were the lone team that Portland could not beat multiple times, going 1-4 on the season against Chicago. Chicago outscored Portland 38-17 this season in 31 innings of play.

TWO OF THE BEST: The Portland Cascade have had an up and down season in the circle, two of the teams more consistent options have been **Carley Hoover** and **Kenzie Brown**. Hoover and Brown join Utah's **Montana Fouts** as two of the three pitchers to make the postseason with more strikeouts than hits allowed on the year.

SOLVING THE PUZZLE: The Portland Cascade pitchers have struggled against the Bandits this season, allowing an ERA of 7.23 against Chicago, while only allowing an ERA of 3.32 to the rest of the league. The Bandits also have a team batting average of .359 against Portland, while the rest of the league is at .247 against Portland.

CONTINUED SUCCESS: While the Cascade offense has struggled against the Bandits this season, the team does have a pair of hitters who have been strong against Chicago this season. **Sydney Stewart** and **Tori Vidales** are a combined 11-for-24 (.458) against the Bandits, while the rest of the team was a combined 22-for-95 (.232).

LATE TO THE PARTY: Portland has struggled in first games of series, going 5-5 in those contests including 0-2 in their two series against the Bandits.

LET MEGAN COOK: "Chef" **Megan Grant** has been one of the best hitters in the AUSL during her rookie season, Grant became one of two players in AUSL history to have double digit home runs in a season with 10. Grant has also put together the longest on base streak this season, reaching in 17 consecutive games, with hits in each of her six games.

STARTING OFF THE RIGHT WAY: Outfielder **Korbe Otis** has been a strong leadoff batter for the Cascade this season, Portland is 14-8 in games that Otis has led off, she has reached base in 20 of the 22 games that she has led off. Otis is currently tied for fourth in the AUSL in runs (20), sixth in RBI (16) and tied for eighth in hits (22).

FIRST TO FOUR: Four appears to be the magic number in games featuring the Cascade, in games in which either the Cascade or their opponents have scored four or more runs, the first team to score four runs is 18-0 ... In games where neither team eclipsed four runs, the Cascade are 5-1.

IS THE OFFENSE ENOUGH?: Portland finished their season with 148 hits, the least in the AUSL. The Texas Volts had the second least amount of hits with 162. Portland also ranked last in batting average (.242), slugging % (.419), doubles (20), stolen bases (4) and total bases (256).

A SEASON OF STREAKS: The Cascade were a streaky team all season, the team won multiple games in a row four separate times and lost multiple games in a row five times. Portland will be hoping to build on their win in the regular season finale.

BREAKING NEW GROUND: Starting pitcher **Kenzie Brown** has had a stellar rookie season in 2026, on 6/14 Brown became the first starting pitcher in AUSL history to reach double digit strikeouts (10), in that same outing, she joined **Montana Fouts** as the first pair of starting pitchers to each go the distance in AUSL regular season history. On 7/7, Brown repeated that feat with **Karlyn Pickens**, as they each went the distance and combined for 18 strikeouts, the most in a single game in AUSL history.

KEEPING THE SEASON ALIVE: The Bandits and Cascade will meet on Thursday in the first-ever play-in game in the AUSL Playoffs. The winner will advance to the AUSL Championship Series against the Talons this weekend.

SEASON WRAP-UP: Chicago won the season series over Portland with four wins in the five games. The Bandits outscored the Cascade 38-17 in five meetings with two run-rule victories and two two-run wins.

WINNER WINNER: The Bandits earned five of six series victories to close out the season as part of their 14 wins in a 16-game span. Chicago dropped their only two games since June 24 on each of the last two Sundays with a 5-4 loss to Portland and a 3-1 loss to Utah.

HOTTEST IN THE LEAGUE: Chicago led the AUSL with 203 hits, 139 runs scored, 39 doubles, and 9 triples, and their team average of 0.311 and on-base percentage of 0.402 sit 28 and 37 points higher than the next teams.

OFFENSIVE EXPLOSION: The Bandits set the AUSL single-game scoring record with 15 runs in last Thursday's win over the Blaze. Overall in the series, Chicago combined to score 22 runs on 30 hits in two games en route to their fourth sweep of the season.

RECORD-SETTING SERIES: Infielder **Skylar Wallace** had one of the best series of her career last week, finishing 9-10 at the plate with four home runs, nine RBIs, and seven runs scored. She matched or set the AUSL single-game record last Thursday with five hits, four runs scored, seven RBIs, and three home runs.

SLUGGING SAMI: Infielder **Sami Williams** is one of the favorites to win the league MVP as she led the AUSL in hits (32), doubles (12), and RBIs (34). She also ranks second in batting average (0.427) and on-base percentage (0.495), third in slugging percentage (0.893) and OPS (1.338), and top-5 in runs (20) and home runs (7).

CASCADE CRUSHERS: Infielder **Sami Williams** and **Skylar Wallace** and outfielder **Morgan Zerkle** were excellent against the Cascade this year, combining for 23 hits, 15 runs, 9 extra-base hits, 21 RBIs, and 8 walks in 5 games.

RETURN OF THE ACE: Pitcher **Lexi Kilfoyl** was excellent in her return from Japan. In her ten games, she has recorded a perfect 6-0 record with one save. She has allowed just 35 hits and 12 earned runs in 43.0 innings with a 1.95 ERA and a 0.95 WHIP, and in her 12.2 innings against Portland, she compiled a 1-0 record with a 3.87 ERA.

STELLAR SANDERCOCK: Pitcher **Kat Sandercock** was dominant in her two starts against the Cascade this season, throwing 13.1 innings with 9 strikeouts and only 2 runs allowed. She compiled a 1.05 ERA and a 0.90 WHIP.

RECORDS FALLING: Infielder **Sami Williams** broke the AUSL RBI record earlier this season with a walk-off home run to defeat the Volts. Williams has driven in 34 runs in 2026, breaking the AUSL record held by **Erin Coffel**. Williams broke the AUSL doubles record, previously held by **Morgan Zerkle**, with her 10th double on Wednesday. She currently leads the league with 12 doubles, double the second-highest total of six.

FOUR SCORE: The Bandits are 23-2 in regular season games all-time when holding their opponents to four runs or fewer, including 12 of their 16 victories in 2026. The two losses both came to Utah on June 10 and July 19.

ONLY TAKES ONE: The Bandits are 9-1 in one-run games against teams not named the Utah Talons over the past two seasons, but they are 1-5 against the Talons in one-run games. Their first one-run win against the Talons in team history came in the 2-1 victory on Saturday afternoon in Portland.

WALK-OFF WINNERS: The Bandits have won three games on walk-offs with a pair of walk-off home runs and a walk-off bunt single. Catcher **Mary Iakopo** launched a walk-off home run against the Blaze on June 16, the first walk-off home run in Chicago history, and infielder **Sami Williams** also walked it off with a home run on July 4 against Texas and a bunt single on a suicide squeeze on July 18 against Utah.

LIVING UP TO THEIR NAME: The Chicago Bandits led the AUSL with 20 stolen bases this season, including a league-high six steals from infielder **Skylar Wallace** and five steals from outfielder **Morgan Zerkle**.
