FOR STARTERS: The Oklahoma City Spark begin a 5-game road trip to conclude the 2026 Athletes Unlimited Softball League regular season with a 2-game set at the Texas Volts, beginning on Tuesday evening.

LAST TIME OUT: The Spark used home runs from **Sarah Gordon**, **Maya Brady** and **Sydney Sherrill**, and benefited from a complete game from Alana Vawter to earn a series win over the league-leading Utah Talons with a 4-2 victory on Sunday night. The victory was the Spark's fourth win in six game and closed the Oklahoma City's home slate for 2026 at 6-6.

PEAKING AT THE RIGHT TIME: The Spark have won four of their last six games after a five-game losing streak from June 22-29. Oklahoma City won its third series of the season after taking 2-of-3 games against Utah this weekend.

VALIANT VAWTER: **Alana Vawter** registered her longest outing of the season after throwing 7.0 innings against Utah on Sunday night. Vawter had pitched 6.0 total innings this season before facing the Talons in the series finale.

SHE'S BACK: **Maya Brady** returned to the lineup after on July 4 after missing the previous four games due to an injury. In her time back from injury, she has a 5-game hit streak and has recorded hits in 15-of-16 games this season (and 21-of-22 in her AUSL regular season career). She also has three home runs in her last four games.

BRADY'S BRAG SHEET: Even though she missed four games to injury, **Maya Brady** leads the AUSL with 19 runs scored, tied for the lead with eight home runs, is fourth in batting average at .431 and is fifth in both hits (22) and runs batted in (16).

ALL OR NOTHING: The Spark lead the AUSL with 31 home runs this season with home runs in 14 of 20 games this season, including multiple long balls in 11 of those contests. With **Sarah Gordon's** long ball on July 12, nine different Spark players have hit home runs. Three of the top-6 of the AUSL's leaders in home runs come from the Spark, including **Maya Brady** (8 - T1st), **Sydney Romero** (7 - T3rd) and **Delanie Wisz** (6 - 6th).

POWERING UP: **Sydney Sherrill** has a current 8-game hit streak after going 1-for-3 on Sunday evening. Sherrill has 12 hits in her last eight games after going 2-for-19 in her previous six contests.

PICKING UP WHERE SHE LEFT OFF: Since joining the Spark on June 23, **Sydney McKinney** has hits in nine of her first 10 games this season, including a 5-game current hit streak. McKinney is batting .472 with nine runs scored. She led the AUSL regular season in batting in 2025 with a .486 mark.

ROUND-TRIPPER ROMERO: **Sydney Romero** hit her seventh home run of the season on Saturday against the Utah Talons. She is tied for third in the AUSL this season.

WISZ KID: **Delanie Wisz** is sixth in the AUSL with six home runs, with the last two long balls being 2-run shots after her first four were solo home runs. Wisz drew a walk in the third inning on Sunday night to extend her streak of reaching base safely to eight consecutive games. However, her 7-game hitting streak came to an end after going 0-for-2 in the series finale.

NEW KID ON THE BLOCK: **Sarah Gordon** was picked up from the Athlete Reserve Pool this past week and saw her first action in a Spark uniform on July 4, scoring a run as a pinch runner against Portland. She played eight games with the Utah Talons earlier in the season, going 6-for-13 (.462) with two runs scored and three runs driven in. Gordon picked up her first professional home run for the Spark on July 12.

HOT STREAK: The Texas Volts are on a franchise-best three-game winning streak entering a two-game series with the Oklahoma City Spark at Dell Diamond that begins Tuesday at 6 p.m. The Volts are coming off the first three-game sweep in team history, taking a trio of contests from Carolina.

CONNECT FOUR: The Volts and Spark meet for the fourth time in the history of the two franchises. Oklahoma City leads the all-time series 2-1 after claiming the season-opening series June 9-11 in Edmond, Okla.

HIGH VOLTAGE: In Monday's 8-0, five-inning win against Carolina, the Volts turned in one of the best offensive performances of the season. It marked the first run-rule victory of the season for Texas. The Volts tied their season high with eight runs scored and set a franchise-record with four runs scored in the first inning. Texas launched three home runs in the game after hitting just two round-trippers in their previous 10 games. The Volts outscored the Blaze 13-3 in the three-game series sweep.

IN A PINCH: The Volts are tied for the AUSL lead with five hits in pinch-hit situations this season. Texas has converted on 31.3 percent (5-of-16) of their pinch-hit opportunities, including **Aliyah Binford's** pinch-hit two run single in the bottom of the fifth inning on Monday that secured the run-rule victory.

DOUBLE YOUR FUN: The Volts are the AUSL leader in double plays turned with 15 on the season, including two in this past Saturday's win against Carolina. Texas has executed five more double plays than the next closest team in the league, as Chicago has turned 10.

IT TAKES TWO: Since the calendar turned to July, the Volts have relied heavily on the double for offensive production. Twelve of Texas' 23 two-baggers this season (52 percent) have come this month (last seven games).

CANADY JAR: Rookie pitcher **NiJaree Canady** is projected to make her ninth appearance and seventh start in the circle on Tuesday. Canady, who owns a 4.02 earned run average in 31.1 innings of work, holds an earned run average of 0.50 in the month of July, allowing just one earned run in 14.0 innings. In her last outing vs. Carolina on Saturday, Canady notched the first win, first shutout and first complete game of her professional career. Canady led Texas Tech to back-to-back NCAA Women's College World Series runner-up showings in 2025 and 2026.

IRON WOMEN: Two Texas pitchers rank among the top-five in the AUSL in terms of appearances in the circle. **Aliyah Binford** is the AUSL-leader in both total appearances (15) and relief appearances (14), while **Rachel Garcia** is fifth in the league with 10 total appearances and tied for third with seven starts. Garcia leads the AUSL in batters struck out looking with 13 and is third in the league with 40 total Ks. Binford (2.87) and Garcia (3.63) rank fourth and fifth, respectively, in the AUSL in earned run average. The Volts are the only team with two players in the top-five of the league's ERA leaders.

THE REAL MVP: Pitcher **Rachel Garcia**, who earned the complete-game shutout against Carolina on Monday, participated in the MLBx All-Star 3-on-3 game in Philadelphia on Sunday, at which she was named the game's Most Valuable Player.

TO-DO LIS: Rookie infielder **Jackie Lis** became the Volts' starting third baseman on June 23 and has started every game since for Texas. Lis hit her first professional home run with a three-run shot in the first inning of Monday's win against Carolina, giving her an AUSL career-best three RBI. Lis also powered Texas' win against the Blaze on Saturday, reaching base three times and driving in the game-winning run. Since becoming the Volts' starting third baseman, Lis has recorded eight of her nine hits, a pair of doubles and a home run.

PEAK EFFICIENCY: Veteran infielder **Sierra Romero**, who has played in 19 games with 17 starts this season, has five hits on the year. Three of those five hits have been home runs and she is third on the Volts' team with seven RBI. Romero's latest round-tripper came in Texas' last outing vs. Carolina on Monday with a solo homer in the fourth.

HERE COMES THE BOONE: Outfielder **Rylie Boone** has hit safely in eight of the Volts' last 10 games. She is the only Texas player to start all 21 games and one of only eight players in the AUSL with 21 starts on the year. Boone is tied for the AUSL lead with 69 at-bats on the season and leads Texas with 23 hits on the season, which ranks fourth in the league. She is hitting a squad-best .333 on the year.
