THE WINNER TAKES IT ALL: Utah dropped its penultimate regular season game to Chicago, 2-1 in eight innings, to set up a pivotal season finale with the Bandits ... The Talons will claim their second-straight AUSL regular season title with a win on Sunday by virtue of owning the tiebreaker over the Bandits.

KNOCKED OFF THE PERCH: Utah fell out of first place for the first time since June 18 with their loss on Saturday ... The Talons have spent a combined 34-of-40 calendar days atop the AUSL standings in 2026 and 66-of-87 days all-time in AUSL regular season history.

BEND, DON'T BREAKKKKKKKKKK: Pitcher **Megan Faraimo** became the first pitcher in AUSL history to strike out at least 10 batters in consecutive starts with her performance in Thursday's 4-3 win over Portland ... Faraimo allowed five hits and a season-high five walks but held the Cascade to a 3-16 clip with runners on base and delivered six of her 10 punchouts with runners aboard ... Opponents are hitting .230 with runners on base against the UCLA product.

FOUTS-TANDING: Pitcher **Montana Fouts** put together one of her best performances of the season on Saturday, allowing one earned run on four hits and a walk in 7.2 innings while striking out 10 Bandits ... Fouts, who set the AUSL's single-game strikeout record with 12 punchouts, joined **Megan Faraimo** as the only pitchers to record double-digit strikeouts in multiple starts... Fouts retired 19 consecutive batters after giving up a walk with one out in the first inning ... The Kentucky native became the first pitcher in the AUSL to reach 60 strikeouts this season ... Fouts took her fourth loss of the year, with Utah's offense scoring two runs or less in each outing.

FLYING ACES: The Talons lead the AUSL with a collective 2.78 earned run average, a .245 opposing batting average, 139 strikeouts and 15 complete games ... **Montana Fouts** leads the AUSL in wins (7), strikeouts (63), complete games (7), innings pitched (62.1) and opposing batting average (.200) while ranking second in earned run average (2.36) ... Pitcher **Georgina Corrick** carries a 1.37 earned run average and a .225 opposing batting average and has struck out 21 batters in 30.2 innings... Pitcher **Megan Faraimo** ranks third with four wins and 45.2 innings pitched and fourth with 42 punchouts, a 3.83 earned run average and a .286 opposing batting average.

COMMANDING THE STRIKE ZONE: Utah's pitching staff holds the league's best strikeout-to-walk ratio of 3.1, firing 139 strikeouts while allowing just 45 walks, with **Montana Fouts** (6.3), **Megan Faraimo** (2.8) and **Georgina Corrick** (2.6) leading the way ... Fouts and Corrick respectively struck out 13 and 12 batters looking and have registered more backwards-Ks than walks ... Offensively, Talons hitters have drawn 65 walks, the second-best tally in the league, and struck out a league-lowest 106 times ... Outfielder **Aliyah Andrews** (nine), infielder **Hannah Flippen** (five) and catcher **Sharlize Palacios** (three) have each walked as often as they have struck out

DON'T NEED MUCH: Utah has found ways to win throughout the 2026 campaign, fashioning a 14-1 record when scoring three or more runs and going 7-4 in their league-record 11 one-run games ... Utah has compiled a perfect 11-0 record when leading after five innings, outscoring opponents 25-14 in the sixth inning or later.

MODELS OF CONSISTENCY: Infielder **Hannah Flippen**, who collected Utah's lone extra-base hit on Saturday, and catcher **Sharlize Palacios** have each hit safely in nine of their last 10 games.

SWISS ARMY KNIFE: Utility player **Sahvanna Jaquish** has reached base safely in a team-high 10 straight games after tallying a single on Saturday ... Jaquish has started at second base in eight games this season, batting 7-for-22 (.318) with three runs scored and two runs batted in and helping Utah to a 5-3 record in those games ... Utah's starting second basemen have combined for a .184 average in the Talons' other 16 contests.

IT TAKES TWO, BABY: The Talons have compiled an 8-1 record on the year when two or more players tally multi-hit games, but are 1-3 when no hitter registers multiple hits ... Utah hitters have collected 36 multi-hit games in 24 outings, headlined by outfielder **Jadelyn Allchin's** seven games with multiple base knocks.

SITUATIONAL HITTING: Utah went 1-for-11 with runners on base in Saturday's loss, dropping to 2-8 on the season when collecting two hits or less with runners on base ... The Talons went 1-for-7 in leadoff situations for the fourth time, dropping to 1-3 in those games.

FOR ALL THE MARBLES: The Bandits and Talons will meet on Sunday with the #1 overall seed and first-round bye on the line. The winner on Sunday will earn the #1 overall seed, and the loser will be forced to play in the play-in game against either the Portland Cascade or Oklahoma City Spark on Thursday.

PLAYOFFS HERE WE COME: Chicago clinched a playoff berth for the second consecutive season on Wednesday with their 7-6 win over the Blaze.

WINNER WINNER: The Bandits have earned five straight series victories as a part of their 13 wins in a 14-game span. Chicago dropped their only game since June 24 last Sunday with the 5-4 loss to Portland. The loss snapped the longest win streak in AUSL history of nine games, breaking the Talons record of eight straight wins.

HOTTEST IN THE LEAGUE: Chicago leads the AUSL with 201 hits, 138 runs scored, 39 doubles, and 9 triples, and their team average of .319 and on-base percentage of .410 sit 31 and 41 points higher than the next teams.

OFFENSIVE EXPLOSION: The Bandits set the AUSL record for runs in a single game with 15 runs in the win over the Blaze on Thursday. Overall in the series, Chicago combined to score 22 runs on 30 hits in two games en route to their fourth sweep of the season.

RECORD-SETTING SERIES: Infielder **Skylar Wallace** had one of the best series of her career this week, finishing 9-10 at the plate with four home runs, nine RBIs, and seven runs scored. She matched or set the AUSL single-game record on Thursday with five hits, four runs scored, seven RBIs, and three home runs.

FROM MIA TO MVP: Infielder **Sami Williams** spent 1,745 days between appearances in the AUSL after making two appearances in 2021, but she has been unbelievable in 2026. Williams is one of the favorites to win the league MVP as she currently leads the AUSL in hits (32), doubles (12), RBIs (34), She also ranks third in on-base percentage (0.511), slugging percentage (0.931), OPS (1.442), and runs scored (20), and she sits fifth with 7 home runs.

RECORDS FALLING: Infielder **Sami Williams** broke the AUSL RBI record earlier this season with a walk-off home run to defeat the Volts. Williams has driven in 34 runs in 2026, breaking the AUSL record held by **Erin Coffel**. Williams broke the AUSL doubles record, previously held by **Morgan Zerkle**, with her 10th double on Wednesday. She currently leads the league with 12 doubles, double the second-highest total of six.

RETURN OF THE ACE: Pitcher **Lexi Kilfoyl** has been excellent in her return from Japan. In her ten games, she has recorded a perfect 6-0 record with one save. She has allowed just 35 hits and 12 earned runs in 43.0 innings with a 1.95 ERA and a 0.95 WHIP. She has also struck out 16 batters to just six walks this season.

MISSING MVP: The reigning AUSL Most Valuable Player and Hitter of the Year, infielder **Erin Coffel**, is on the Injured List for the Bandits, leaving a hole in their lineup. She currently leads the league with 15 walks, tying the AUSL record for walks in a season. She also ranks second with a .564 OBP and ranks fourth with 5 doubles.

FOUR SCORE: The Bandits are 23-1 in regular season games all-time when holding their opponents to four runs or fewer, including 11 of their 15 victories in 2026. The lone loss came in a 1-0 game with Utah on June 10.

ONLY TAKES ONE: The Bandits are 9-1 in one-run games against teams not named the Utah Talons over the past two seasons, but they are 1-5 against the Talons in one-run games. Their first one-run win against the Talons in team history came in the 2-1 victory on Saturday afternoon in Portland.

WALK-OFF WINNERS: The Bandits have won three games on walk-offs with a pair of walk-off home runs and a walk-off bunt single. Catcher **Mary Iakopo** launched a walk-off home run against the Blaze on June 16, the first walk-off home run in Chicago history, and infielder **Sami Williams** also walked it off with a home run on July 4 against Texas and a bunt single on a suicide squeeze on July 18 against Utah.

LIVING UP TO THEIR NAME: The Chicago Bandits lead the AUSL with 18 stolen bases this season, including a league-high five steals from infielder **Skylar Wallace** and four steals from outfielder **Morgan Zerkle**.
