FINAL INSTALLMENT: The Texas Volts commence their final series of the 2026 season at 7 p.m. CT Friday when they open a two-game road swing with the Portland Cascade at Hillsboro Ballpark in Hillsboro, Ore.

PARTY OF FOUR: The Volts and Cascade are meeting for the fourth time in the history of the two franchises. Portland swept a three-game series in Round Rock, June 26-28. The Portland Cascade are one of two Athletes Unlimited Softball League expansion franchises for the 2026 season.

CURTAIN CALL: Veteran infielder **Sierra Romero** has announced that the 2026 AUSL campaign will be her last, as she will be retiring at the end of the season. Romero, who was honored in a pre-game ceremony in Round Rock on Wednesday, has been part of Athletes Unlimited since 2022 and was selected by the Volts in the 12th Round of the 2025 AUSL Inaugural Draft. She also played professional in the NPF and was the No. 2 overall draft selection by the USSSA Pride in 2016. She has competed internationally both for Team USA and Team Mexico. This season for the Volts, Romero has played in 21 games with 19 starts, hitting .159. Four of her seven hits this season have gone for extra bases, including three home runs.

FIVE ALIVE: Entering Monday's game, the Volts had hit just two home runs in their previous 10 contests. Already this week (3 games), Texas has smashed five home runs, including a pair of round-trippers by **Jackie Lis**. The Volts have 22 long balls on the year, which is tied for third-most among AUSL teams. Nine different Texas players have hit home runs in 2026.

DOUBLE YOUR FUN: The Volts are the AUSL leader in double plays turned with 16 on the season. Texas has executed five more double plays than the next closest team in the league, as Chicago has turned 11.

CAUGHT YOUR EYE: Texas leads the AUSL in strikeouts looking with 47 and **Rachel Garcia** has an AUSL-leading 19 strikeouts looking. Forty percent of the Volts' 117 total punchouts this season have been looking.

CALLING THEM HOME: Texas is the most productive team in the AUSL with a runner on third base and less than two outs. The Volts have converted on 62.5 percent (20-for-32) of those opportunities. In addition, Texas is hitting a league-best .364 (4-for-11) with the bases loaded this season. In pinch hit opportunities, the Volts have a league-best six hits this season, going 6-for-20 in those situations.

CALLING CARD(A): Veteran pitcher **Ally Carda** is projected to make her ninth appearance and fifth start in the circle for the Volts on Friday. Carda, who has worked 22.0 innings for the Volts, has an 0-2 record and a 3.82 earned run average with nine strikeouts. She joined Texas on June 23 after completing her Japan Diamond League season. Carda has also played a pivotal role on the base paths for the Volts. In the series sweep of Carolina, Carda scored the winning run on July 10 and crossed the plate for the final run in an 8-0 run-rule on July 13, both as a pinch runner.

RECORD WATCH: Pitcher **Aliyah Binford** is tied for the AUSL lead in total pitching appearances (15) and games finished (7) and leads the league with 14 relief appearances. She will match the AUSL single-season record for total appearances next time she enters the circle. Binford leads the Volts with a 2.87 earned run average and is tied for second on her team with 18 strikeouts. She has worked 31.2 innings this season with a 3-3 record.

HERE COMES THE BOONE: Outfielder **Rylie Boone** is the only Volts player to start all 23 games this season. She is tied for the AUSL lead with 76 at-bats this season and her team-best 26 hits are tied for third in the league. After being held hitless on Monday and Tuesday, Boone exploded for a 3-for-4 performance on Wednesday vs. Oklahoma City. It was her second three-hit game of the season and she has hit safely in 15 of her 20 games at the plate.

DEJAH VU: Catcher **Dejah Mulipola** is riding a season-best four-game hit streak entering Friday night's game. She joined the Volts on June 23 after completing her season in the Japan Diamond League. Mulipola has played in 14 games with 12 starts, hitting a team-best .355 on the year. She has 11 hits, including three doubles, and five RBI. Mulipola hit her first home run of the season in Wednesday's game vs. Oklahoma City.

HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR: Selections for the 2026 AUSL All-Star Cup have been announced and five Volts have made the list, including **Aliyah Binford**, **Rylie Boone**, **Rachel Garcia**, **Tiare Jennings** and **Dejah Mulipola**. The 2026 AUSL All-Star Cup takes place August 8-30 in Rosemont, Ill.

SETTING THE TABLE: Three teams make the playoffs in the AUSL, currently the Talons are in first place at 15-8 with a tiebreaker over the second place Bandits, also 15-8. The Cascade are in third place at 13-10, Portland cannot become the number one seed after their loss to Utah, as Utah and Chicago play one another for their final series. Portland could earn the two seed if they sweep the Volts and the Bandits sweep the Talons. Also at play are the Oklahoma City Spark who currently sit in fourth at 11-11, a game and a half behind Portland. OKC holds the tiebreaker over the Cascade.

HOPING FOR MORE OF THE SAME: The Portland Cascade have two games remaining, as the team enters its final series against the Texas Volts. Portland managed to sweep the Volts in Texas. Texas currently sits in last place in the standings. at 6-17.

STARTING OFF THE RIGHT WAY: Outfielder **Korbe Otis** has been a strong leadoff batter for the Cascade this season, Portland is 13-6 in games that Otis has led off, she has reached base in 18 of the 20 games that she has led off. Otis is currently tied for sixth in the AUSL in runs (16), seventh in hits (22), and eighth in RBI (16).

FIRST TO FOUR: Four appears to be the magic number in games featuring the Cascade, in games in which either the Cascade or their opponents have scored four or more runs, the first team to score four runs is 16-0 ... In games where neither team eclipsed four runs, the Cascade are 5-1.

MAKING A GOOD FIRST IMPRESSION: In her rookie season, **Megan Grant** has been one of the main producers for the Cascade's offense, currently apart of a tie with the Spark's **Maya Brady** and **Sydney Romero**, as well as Carolina's **Reese Atwood** for the league lead with eight home runs, is tied for fourth in the league for RBIs (17) and second in walks (13) ... Grant currently has more home runs (8) than all of her other hits combined (7) ... Grant has reached base in 15 consecutive games.

BREAKING NEW GROUND: Starting pitcher **Kenzie Brown** has had a stellar rookie season in 2026, on 6/14 Brown became the first starting pitcher in AUSL history to reach double digit strikeouts (10), in that same outing, she joined **Montana Fouts** as the first pair of starting pitchers to each go the distance in AUSL regular season history. On 7/7, Brown repeated that feat with **Karlyn Pickens**, as they each went the distance and combined for 18 strikeouts, the most in a single game in AUSL history.

A SEASON OF STREAKS: The Cascade have been a streaky team, the team has had four winning streaks this season after their wins against the Bandits and the Talons, however the team has also had four losing streaks so far this season. Portland will look to avoid a five losing streak tonight.

MAKING IT A MARATHON, NOT A SPRINT: Wednesday's game between the Cascade and Talons ended due to run rule after the fifth inning, during the 2026 AUSL season there have been nine games that ended after the fifth inning due to the run rule. Four of those games have ended in a Cascade loss, two have now ended in a cascade win. No team other than the Cascade has been run ruled in back-to-back games this season, while the Bandits are the only other team to lose multiple games by being run ruled at the end of the fifth inning. Portland is 1-0 in extra inning games.

IS THE OFFENSE ENOUGH?: Wednesday marked the first game that the Cascade registered double digit hits. Despite sitting in third in the AUSL standings, the Cascade offense has struggled, producing the fewest hits in the AUSL. Portland has managed to score more than three runs only nine times, three of which coming against the Volts, who have given up the most runs of any team this season.

A WELCOME RETURN: Wednesday marked the first start for **Paige Sinicki** with the Cascade. Sinicki is no stranger to playing softball in Oregon, as she started 211 career games for the University of Oregon at shortstop. Sinicki ranks seventh all-time for the Ducks in both career stolen bases (65) and career triples (9) ... In Sinicki's first full series start- ing she recorded the second three-hit game of the season for the Cascade and was 5-of-9 overall.
